Adam fought the British, while his mother, wife and children endured deprivation and danger on the family farm in the midst of the battle. The story of Adam's two loves -- his first wife Jennetta who died bearing their son and his second wife Elizabeth who bore him 12 more children -- creates the human backdrop to the historical events of Revolutionary War times.
