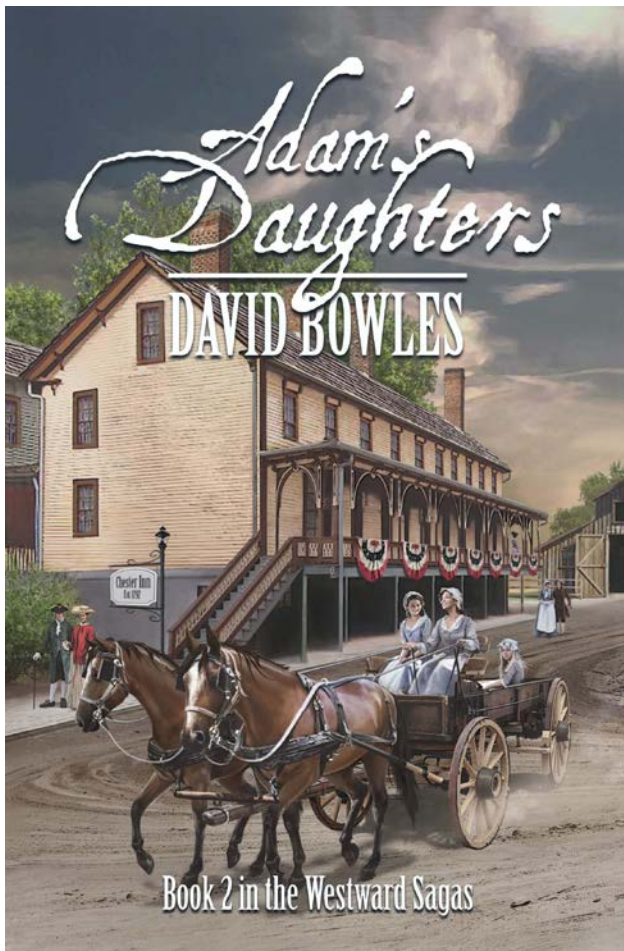


The Westward Sagas tell the story of the Mitchell family's 100-year odyssey west from Pennsylvania to Texas.
